Whether it is fishing, canoeing, or farming we would like to have you be a part of shaping our next generation's life and their experiences with the ocean. This is a great opportunity to share and maintain the culture surrounding our islands and our oceans. / **Aikke ghut aramas kka re schimaang llól sáát me re mwuschel ngalewow ghuleeyár reel sáát. - Have a deep understanding of the ocean and how it is important to our islands and culture? / **E tumwógh ghuleeyómw reel sáát me efaisál ghatchúl ngáli mil kka faluwasch me kkoosch?**
- Have a willingness to share your skills and knowledge with our youth regarding ocean conservation? / **Ebwung ngálugh bwe ubwe ngalleer olighát ghuleeyómw reel meeta sibwe aghatchú yaasch sáát reel?**
- Have an interest in providing information about customs, beliefs, and practices that are tied to our ocean? / **Eyoor mwuschelúm w bwe ubwe isiisewow arongorong reel kko, lúghúlugh me meeta kka sighal féerú reel mwóghutughutúl sáát?**
- Want to work with middle school and college students? / **U mwuschel ubwe angaang me ate kka re lo llól middle school me college?**
- Value a learning exchange with our youth about how science compares with traditional knowledge? / **Eyoor mwotal/yóómw aschengescheng reel yáami allillis fengál me yáát reel efaisúl yaasch ghal aweweey fengáliiy Science me Kko?**

If you answered yes to these questions, we hope that you would consider working with Project Hope-Healthy Oceans and People Empowerment-A project funded by the Administration for Native Americans (ANA) with a goal of improving 6th grade public school science test scores through ocean conservation awareness. / **Ngáre u llegh reel ayyegh kkaal, ai tettengágh bwe u mwuschel angaang ngáli Project Hope-Healthy Oceans and People Empowerment-Eyoor salaapiyal mereel Administration for Native Americans (ANA) bwe ebwe allanga yaar Science test scores ate kka re llól oloow sessár reel yaar akkabwung kkapasal sáát.**

Our test method is aimed at utilizing an inter-generational exchange of culture and science between students and elders. Our design uses conservation teams consisting of 1 Ocean Elder, 2 NMC ENRO college students and 30 6th grade students. / **Tees ye sibwe yáaya ngáre si súl ngáli yaar schuu yáát me tufeey reel kkapasal Science me kko. Schóó kka rebwe toolong llól amalawal moghutughut yeel nge tufeey (escháy) iye e roong llól sáát, attél NMC (ruuscháy) me ate kka re lo llól oloow sessár (eliigh me leyúr).**

Initially there will be 3 conservation teams who will do a variety of ocean conservation related activities, a stewardship project, and attend an ocean conservation camp. We anticipate we need you for 2-3 hours per week and might be on varying days both on weekdays and weekends. Our activities will run from approximately February to June. Expenses related to your participation will be covered by our grant. You will be asked to sign a letter of commitment, contribute to surveys and help keep track of your participation. / **Bweletáál nge ebwe yoor eluuw ttetteliir schó kka rebwe apay llól meeta ikka sibwe amwuschú reel mwoghutughutúl sáát. Abwósul yóómw tabweey yéélágh yeel nge ebwe toowow mellól selaapiyal ANA. Imwu ebwe yoor kkata la ubwe makkeey reel yóómw tabweey yéélágh yeel, ubwe bwal toolong llól survey ikka re ayoora me ebwal alisúúgh reel yóómw kke tabweey.**
